Application CM/0018/20 to Buckinghamshire Council refused on 9th December following technical issues raised about status of application as a section 73 application. No appeal lodged as yet.

It was resolved that Newton Longville Parish Council supports other local councils in strongly objecting to the extension of the current landfill operation due to the impact on residents.

Newton Longville Parish Council notes that in considering its response little information has been available on how the site will be restored without voids being filled with waste as originally planned. If the Appeal is refused then steps clearly

need to be taken by Milton Keynes Council, Buckinghamshire Council and the Environment Agency to ensure that communities in this area are not negatively impacted by the consequences of that decision over the long term (including any potential issues with land stability, slippage, associated drainage, leachate leakage and gas treatment).

It was resolved that Newton Longville Parish Council seeks Rule 6 status in the Appeal.
