### **STAGING**

The Show will be at the Village Hall, Paradise, Newton Longville.

Exhibitors may bring Handicrafts, Photographs and any non-perishable entries to the Hall on Friday 3rd September - 7pm to 8.30pm

All other Classes to the Hall from 8am on the Saturday morning.

Upon arrival you will be given cards for all that you entered to place by/on your entries by the Class Co-ordinators for the different Sections.

Water is available to fill vases and jars.

#### CLASS 79 **ALLOTMENT COMPETITION**

Anyone having an Allotment on the Whaddon Road site can enter their plot in this Class, to be judged prior to the Show by a member of the Parish Council. Judging to be done as follows, based on RHS guidelines:

\* Condition of plot

\*Good workmanship

\*Quality of crops, flowers, fruit & vegetables

\*Layout and planting

First, Second and Third awards will be given.

Entrants will be advised in advance as to when the judging will take place. There is no fee for this class.

### **Newton Longville Show Rules and Guidance - for our exhibitors**

- Entries must be made on the form below; copies can be made for additional exhibitors.
- No late entries will be accepted. See the Schedule for cut-off date and time.
- Only one entry per class by each exhibitor is allowed.
- Entries are allowed from all villagers, those past and present and anyone who has a link with the village through family relations or relatives, a family member attending school. through business, employment etc.
- Entries are only to be made from amateurs and novices. We ask that children's work is their own.
- All exhibits must be made or grown by the exhibitor and remain on show until 3.30 pm.
- Competitors must provide their own staging items, cake stands, paper plates, vases etc. to exhibit their items.
- Individual entries only unless otherwise specified.
- Staging of exhibits to be completed between times specified for your Class.
- Entries must not be removed before the end of prize-giving. Any entries left will become the property of the Show Committee.
- Please ensure your entries are clearly labelled and dated and bottles/jars are full. e.g., RASPBERRY JAM, August 2021. Please highlight any possible allergens, i.e., nuts.
- Only Judges and Officials can remain in the Hall during judging.
- The Committee regret that they will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- All decisions by the Judges will be final.
- Certificates will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in Class. Rosettes will be awarded for best three in the Section. There will also be several Cups awarded for effort within the Sections. An overall Shield will be awarded based on a points system for winning entries throughout the Show. 15 points for 1st, 10 points for 2nd and 5 points for 3rd. If there is a tie, then the winner will be chosen by Judges.
- Children's class entries will receive a Village Show gift for entering, and rosettes for 1st 2nd & 3rd in each of those classes. There will also be a small number of prizes given for: Best Overall, Outstanding Effort and Special Talent.
